- Wash all dishware, utensils, pots, pans and other cookware.
- Follow proper rules of hygiene and food safety measures.
- Take out trash and rinse garbage cans.
- Clean and stock restrooms.
- Sweep and mop floors, especially in the event that items are broken or spilled.
- Support other restaurant staff by assisting with other tasks to ensure that the kitchen and dining areas are cleaned and prepared for guests.

You have prior restaurant experience working in a fast-paced environment, and have good communication skills. You like being part of a team and you are courteous and friendly to others.
